


"Sun, Sun, Earth"

"Rainy Day Obstacle Course"

On rainy days the children may assist in planning and creating an indoor obstacle course using available items in your classroom.

The obstacle course might include:

- Crawling under tables
- Walking around cots
- Climbing over chairs
- Walking a balance beam created with long flat blocks or masking tape
- Hopping in and out of hula hoops

Materials

- Classroom items to create an obstacle course, such as tables, chairs, cots, blocks, hula hoops



Gross Motor Skills

Combines a sequence of large motor skills

Demonstrates strength and coordination of large muscles to engage in skills such as jumping, hopping, and running
